What's it like to be a single father? Marvin Sapp knows now.

The Gospel singer just landed a reality show that documents his life as the

only parent for his three teenage children.

Two years ago, his wife MaLinda died after losing a battle against colon cancer. The pair ran Lighthouse Full Life Center Church in Grand Rapids, Mich.

Since her passing, the singer and now full time dad says life is an adventure.

"There are days when I get up and I cry, thinking of her. There are days thinking of her and I smile. There are days when I'm angry. Days that I'm not... we miss her."

The show, produced by Open River Pictures, actually began filming earlier this year, but hasn't been assigned to a network yet. Tammy Williams, CEO of the company, says this is a new phase in the family's journey, serving as a beacon of hope, family and love. "Marvin entrusted my company to document the second chapter of his and his kids lives," said Williams. "I think it is timely that the country sees a man, especially an African-American man, who is serious about
