They asked permission to drill a wildcat well, and he signed a lease contract. At 1,115 feet they struck a huge oil reserve. The first well came in at 80,000 barrels a day. Many subsequent wells were more than twice as large. In fact, 30 years after the discovery, a government test of one of the wells showed it still had the potential flow of 125,000 barrels of oil a day. And Mr. Yates owned it all. He had huge reserves just waiting for him to claim. The day he purchased the land he had received the oil and mineral rights. Yet, he'd been living on relief. A multimillionaire living in poverty. I must make certain that I am aware and receive all of the riches that the Holy Spirit within me provides that I may be kingdom-rich and not be a multimillionaire living in poverty. I must discover that huge reserve of power that can be released through proper exposure to spiritual worship. V. In v.5 I notice how Isaiah mentioned five (5) things that described himself as he accessed God during this high worship moment.

VI. In vv.6,7 Isaiah gives to me great spiritual clues of what should be the conclusions of my high moments of worship having been led by the Holy Spirit. At least two (2) things are listed as to what the results of my Holy Ghost led authentic worship should yield to me personally.

VII. I can list the five (5) words that Isaiah used in v.8 that speaks of how the Holy Spirit is making me ready to serve God after a spirit led worship.
