

The last game Toyelle Wilson coached for Prairie View A&M was against Baylor in the NCAA Tournament. The next game she coaches will be as a coach of those same Lady Bears.

Wilson has accepted a position as an assistant coach at Baylor, according to a source close to the team. She has guided Prairie View to the NCAA Tournament via Southwest Athletic Conference Tournament titles in all three of her seasons as head coach.

Wilson finished her third season at Prairie View A&M as the most successful coach in Prairie View A&M women's basketball history. In just three seasons, Wilson captured three consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances in as many seasons. She led the Lady Panthers to a perfect 9-0 record in the Southwestern Athletic Conference Tournament and leaves the program with a coaching record of 36-18 in SWAC play and 55-43 overall. Prairie View had been to the NCAA Tournament twice in the previous 29 years before Wilson took over as head coach. Both of those appearances came while Wilson was an assistant coach.
